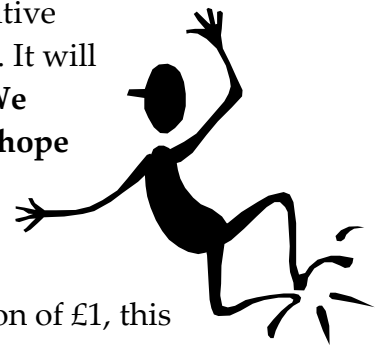

## LIFE EDUCATION CENTRE

Life Education Centre (LEC) is a charity which provides unique health education and drug prevention programmes for children in primary schools. LEC works in partnership with schools, parents/carers and the community to help children make healthy choices by delivering educational programmes in the specially designed mobile classroom which is equipped to provide a stimulating and exciting learning experience.

The LEC is again visiting South Norwood Primary (this is the third consecutive annual visit), tomorrow (Thursday), Friday and next Monday and Tuesday. It will again be based in the large Junior playground beside the Lobster Library. **We have arranged a parent session for tomorrow from 8.45-9.00am, when we hope you can visit the LEC and have a taste of what your children will be learning.**



As with previous years, if each child could please make a voluntary donation of £1, this will help considerably towards the cost of the LEC, which costs £1,200.00 in total for the four days. 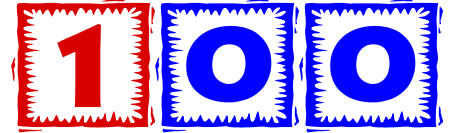


## YEAR 6 SATS MEETING

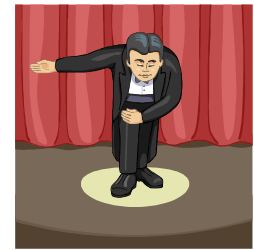


### PHONICS WORKSHOP
