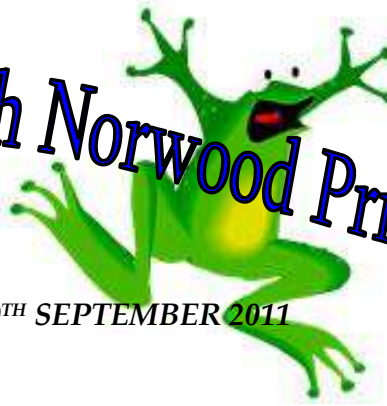

So, what is happening this year?
